We are looking at a new system called "Lunchbox by School CashOnline" coming soon This year's spiritual theme is "Listening With the Ear of the Heart" Parish dates have been set for a variety of events. We will be travelling to the SFDS Parish by bus for in-person Mass on our SFDS Feast Day. Guest Speaker Aubrey Noronha ("Why Being Not Racist Isn't Enough Anymore") is scheduled to hold a parent presentation on October 12, 2022 at 7pm at Notre Dame CSS, Ajax. We are looking to have him present to the Primary & Junior divisions soon. He previously presented his Colour Blind 1.0 and 2.0 programs to the Intermediates. We currently have 4 Lunchtime Supervisors! Volunteers need to have current police check. It is now done online, with a mail delivery time of approx. 3 weeks. PRYDE has closed their before/after school program due to staffing issues. Mrs. Accardi will continue to advocate for their return. Student Achievement & Well-being: Science of Reading: The Ontario Human Rights Commission Right to Read inquiry report is recommending this evidence-based decoding/phonics program to ensure more equitable opportunities and
